

Starting Tuesday, February 2nd, all Farmington High School Juniors will participate in Prairie State Achievement Exam (PSAE) training. Four sessions will be ACT preparation and 6 sessions will be KeyTraining.

KeyTrain is an online learning component that provides related lessons geared toward the WorkKeys portion of the ACT. There are four main components of KeyTrain: pre-tests, courses, topic lessons, and quizzes.

KeyTrain is not an inclusive preparation for the ACT but will help students prepare for the work place skills portion. The only sections of KeyTrain that are included in the PSAE are the Applied Math and the Reading for Information portions.
